We are delighted to announce that our students have excelled by producing our best ever A Level results with some exceptional individual performances. Overall, these results constitute a great achievement for both students and staff. Over half of all grades are at A* - B and just under 80% A* - C. The vast majority of students were accepted on their first-choice degree and will study at some of the most prestigious universities in the country including London School of Economics, Manchester, Royal Holloway, SOAS and Kings College London. We are exceptionally proud of all our students, and the resilience and perseverance they have shown over the past two years in completing their A levels.

We are particularly pleased that Cherie achieved BBB in Biology, Chemistry and Maths and will study Medicine at University of Manchester. Cherie will be the first Phoenix Academy student to study Medicine. Nadira achieved AAB in Biology, Politics and RS and will study Diagnostic Radiography at St Georges, University of London. Zaynab achieved A*A*B will study International Relations and History at London School of Economics. Head Girl Maria will study International Relations at Royal Holloway.

GCSE Results Day

Following on from the best ever results for A level, the academy is pleased to announce record breaking results at GCSE. GCSE results at 4+ (C) in English and Maths were over 90%, with just under a third of all GCSE entries between a grade 9 and 7 (A* - A). Progress in English, Maths and Science continues to improve, with outstanding results enabling students to choose the A Level subjects that will prepare them for university. Achievement in the EBACC (English Baccalaureate) is in line with national standards. Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Spanish and Latin achieved 80% and above at grade 5. 60% of students achieved 5+ in English, Citizenship, RS, Drama, History, and computer Science. 27% of all Geography results were grade 7+.

This year 11 students achieved at least four grade 8 or above. Anas, Ragda, Dana, Mohammed, Yahya, Ayub, Hassane, John, Allegra, Karis and China.

Well done to all students on their achievements! We are proud of you all on achieving this fantastic set of results. The past three years have been challenging; however, you have overcome these challenges to achieve a great set of results which allow you to access the next stage of your education. I know how pleased staff, your families and governors are for you and share my congratulations in your success.
