Dear Parents/Carers and Year 11 Pupils,

The contents of this letter outlines important information affecting our Year 11 pupils in the weeks ahead. Year 11 students will be leaving school following the completion of the Teacher Assessed Grade process, schools are encouraged to provide transitional guidance and activities to Year 11, which will enable pupils to progress to their next place of education or employment. It is at the discretion of individual schools how they approach this.

Providing opportunities for our young people to learn and to flourish is central to our ethos at Phoenix Academy. We therefore want our pupils to be in school every day until **Friday 28**<sup>th</sup> **May.** 

#### **Curriculum and Learning Experience**

Our curriculum, subsequent to the Teacher Assessed Grade process, will provide pupils with some of the following:

- The opportunity to study topics adversely affected by the lockdown
- The opportunity to study areas of the curriculum not assessed, providing further depth and broader knowledge to topics
- A-level taster lessons
- Information about careers and guidance on college and apprenticeship applications
- Additionally, pupils may have time to complete missed assessments

## Monday 24th to Friday 28th May 2021, 10-12pm

From **Monday 24<sup>th</sup> May** we are only expecting students to attend school from **10.00 am-12.00 pm**. We have organised a bespoke curriculum experience for Year 11 with the focus continuing to be on preparing pupils for further education and employment. This will include a mixture of normal lessons and the following enrichment activities:

- Lessons provided by various colleges
- Sessions on careers, interview techniques, transition to college, personal finance and online safety
- Mental health wellbeing sessions provided by the Mind particularly focusing on coping with change, anxiety and pressure
